Dear Parents/Carers,

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Snow!

Friday's snow came as a bit of a surprise in terms of the amount of snow we woke up to! Hopefully the communication from the school was timely and clear; it is always a challenge taking the decision to close and awaiting authorisation from SLC knowing the forecast was to change later in the day however in terms of staff and pupil safety it was not possible for many to get to Braehead and school transport understandably was not operating on Friday morning. Google Classroom was therefore set up with literacy and numeracy tasks to allow continuity of learning for your child/children and we were pleased to see the uptake this received. Staff were available to support learners from home and any queries were resolved quickly to allow pupils to continue with tasks.

Outdoor Shoes

As previously intimated children are welcome to change their shoes when they arrive in school especially on wet, snowy days, there is absolutely no problem with that. I have to make clear however that the change of shoes should be stored in a carrier bag and placed under the child's seat. We must keep our surfaces clear to allow for the enhanced cleaning which is taking place four times per day in the school. You will appreciate too that we are trying to avoid children being huddled together in cloakroom spaces and with the additional time the hand washing takes from time in class we want to avoid unnecessary time being lost to change shoes. While it may seem like only a few minutes it is a few minutes as many as eight times per day. Over the course of the week this time adds up to quite a significant amount.

Christmas Plans

As you are aware the Christmas Parties and Activity Days are Thursday 17 December and Friday 18 December. We have purchased a pantomime for the children to watch and had planned for this on Wednesday 16 December following our festive lunch. You will by now have seen the news that schools will be closing and reopening on the original planned dates therefore we will be showing the panto on Monday 21 December instead as we hope to keep learning and teaching as normal as possible until the party days.

Our panto is called A Lad in Govan (Aladdin) and features some stars from River City; we hope it will be enjoyable for the children. As a small school I have managed to obtain a 50% discount on the cost of this however there will be no cost to the children this year.

For our festive lunch we are hoping to be able to bring the children together into the hall with appropriate distancing being observed and ventilation in place at all times. It certainly helps

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add to the atmosphere however I would like to reassure all parents that there will be at least 4m distance between each class in the hall.

Change to Menu 22 December

Instead of chicken sandwiches on Tuesday 22 December it will be ham sandwiches.

Enrolment Week

This year enrolment week takes place week beginning 18 January 2021. As always I would encourage all parents to spread the word to those people who have children who live within Braehead Primary catchment and are due to start school in August 2021. Parents require the full birth certificate and two utility bills dated within the last 3 months showing the home address in order to complete the enrolment. We await further guidance around the physical process of enrolment itself and parents being in school; when this is received it will be communicated.
