Welcome Back!

It is lovely to see all the children back in school today after the Spring Break. Lunches

We have a Rag Bag collection arranged for 19 May, anyone with anything to contribute can do so before that date, thank you.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club restarted today after more than a year without it. For those children attending Breakfast Club for the first time they should make their way to the back playground and enter the school building via the back entrance. Parents are welcome to assist children by walking them round to the back door however parents should not enter the school building. There is now a lever handle on the back door to assist the younger pupils with entry to the school. After leaving their child/children in the back playground parents should leave via the 3pm gate rather than going back down the entry path – please keep this operating as a one way system in the mornings. Once in the school building children should deposit coats and bags on the coat pegs and make their way to the dining room where staff will be waiting to assist pupils. As was the case last session the back door and gates will remain locked until 8:15am, pupils should not be in the school grounds before this time.

Work Programme

There will be changes to my work programme over the coming weeks due to mandatory training and planning for visiting services' safe return to school buildings. There is, in the meantime, a virtual meeting for the P7 children and Mrs Ewing, pupil support teacher from Lanark Grammar School where the children will be able to hear about life at LGS and ask questions.
