Parent Council - Potential Tennis After School Club

The Parent Council have continued to work hard to achieve funding for the school. You will see from the minutes posted on the Parent Council Facebook page that a £1000 grant was received from Tesco for the purpose of after school clubs. All being well in terms of restrictions and appropriate permissions from SLC the Parent Council plan to run a block of tennis after school clubs for children in P1-4 and another club for those children in P5-7 to prevent the mixing of bubbles. In line with government restrictions these could take place if necessary indoors as tennis is a non-contact activity however our plan is to hold these outdoors to increase mitigations regarding COVID-19. There are maximum number restrictions in place with the tennis coach so in preparation for this club, should we be able to proceed with it, we are trying to get an idea of the children who would be interested in attending. I am going to set up a poll on the Facebook page to obtain this information. Those parents who are not members of the Facebook group I would ask you to let me know if your child would like to attend before Wednesday 28 April, thank you. As I say this is not set in stone, we are simply trying to be as prepared as possible should we receive work this can proceed.
