Uniform Swap

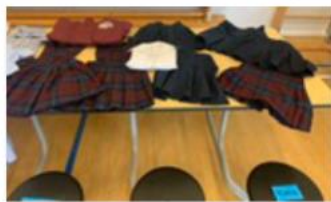
Today is our Uniform Swap!

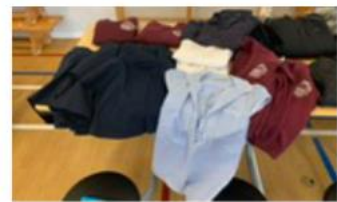
We have lots of stock from ages 5-9 and some older sizes.



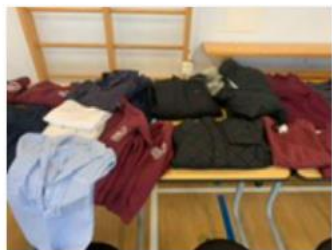

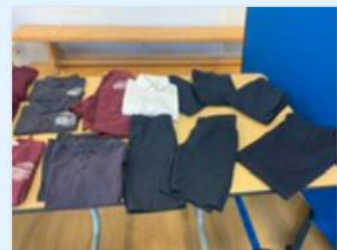

A few points to note about the morning:
