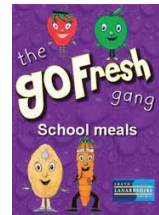
Our vision at Braehead is to provide a positive and engaging learning environment which challenges and supports all children to be the best they can be.

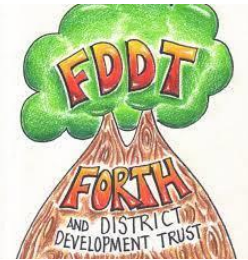


Flu Vaccination
