Swimming



We are now in a position where we are able to return to swimming lessons. We have requested Block 1 which begins next week and have asked for Tuesday mornings. We await confirmation of our slot but wanted to communicate as early as possible that it is very likely that all P4-7 children will be attending swimming lessons for 9 weeks from next week. In conjunction with our commitment to keeping the cost of the school day as low as possible, there will be a very small charge of £1 per week to help with transport costs. We are using the funds allocated from the

participatory budget exercise carried out last session as well as the school's activities budget to cover this cost. Swimming is a life skill and therefore worthy of the investment. The £1 weekly charge can be made through parent pay.

Braehead Primary School Parent Consultations - Tuesday 2 November 2020

Where possible appointments will be allocated based on the selections made in the Google Form.

- Appointments will last around 7 minutes.
- The phone call from your child's teacher is likely to be displayed as a 'withheld' or 'unavailable' number.
- Please do not put the call on 'loudspeaker' until you have confirmed with the teacher if this is suitable. You do not have permission to record the call.
- Before starting the consultation your child's teacher will ask you to confirm your child's full name and DOB.
- If you get cut off for any reason, your child's teacher will try and call you back, unless your allocated time has already been used.

- Appointments will be allocated once the Google link closes.

Timings need to be adhered to in order to ensure that each parent gets the same opportunity to discuss their child's progress. The teacher will 'close' the meeting at the end of the appointment to ensure that they can move onto the next call - should you feel there is something else you need to discuss in more detail please contact the school office to make an appointment to speak to Mrs Steele.
