### **P1 Dental Checks**

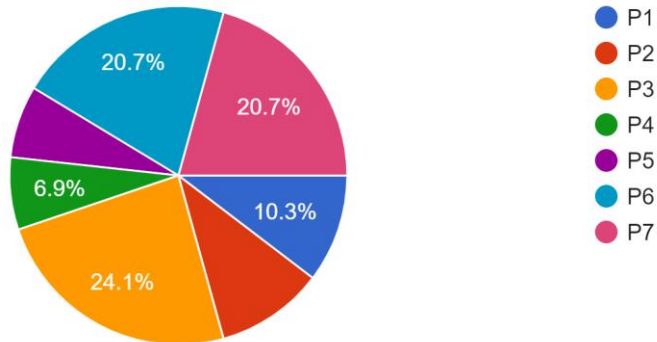
Please note the P1 dental checks will be on Thursday 3 March in the school at 9:15am. Further information will be sent home nearer this date.

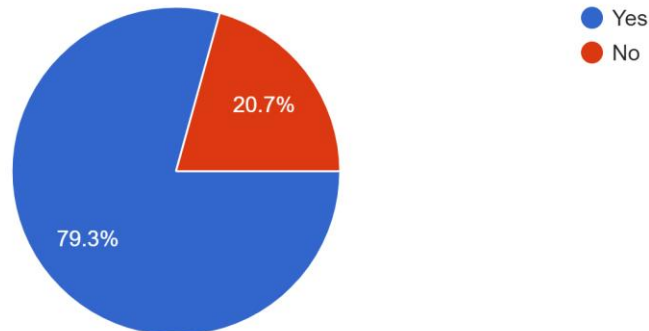
What stage is your child?

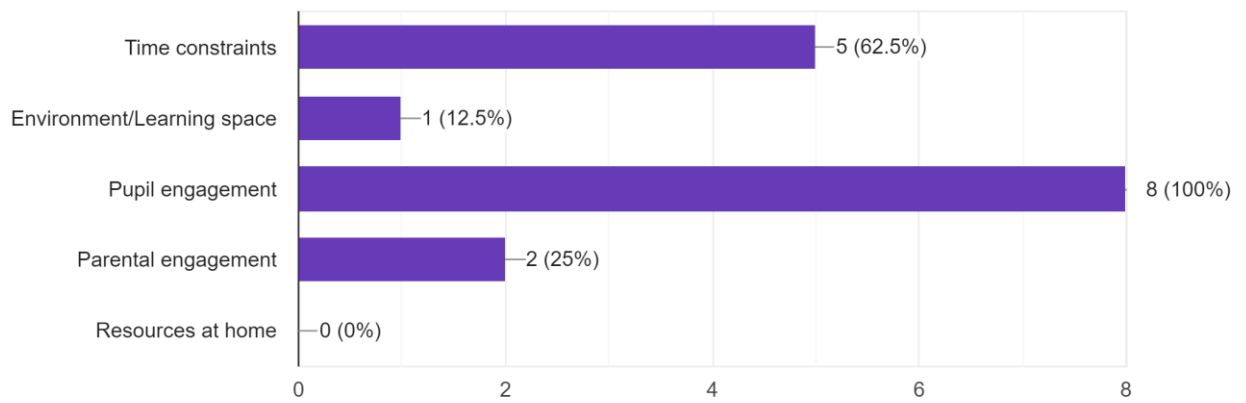
Does your child complete their homework?

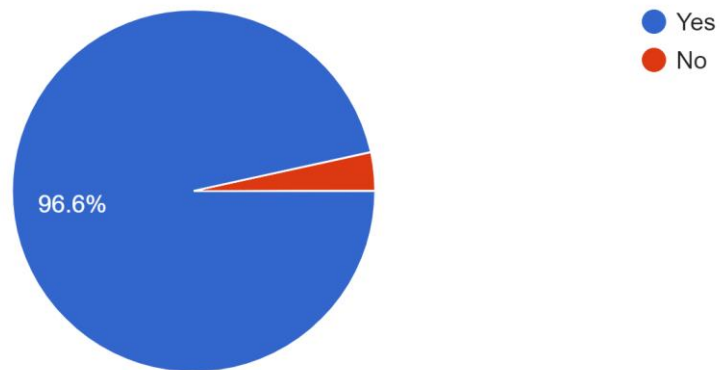
If not, why not? Please select all that apply.

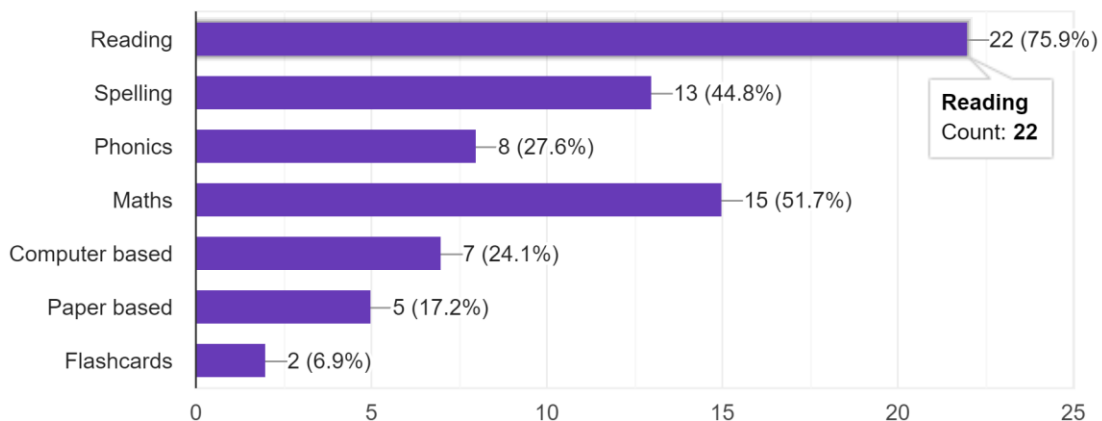
Do you support your child with their homework?

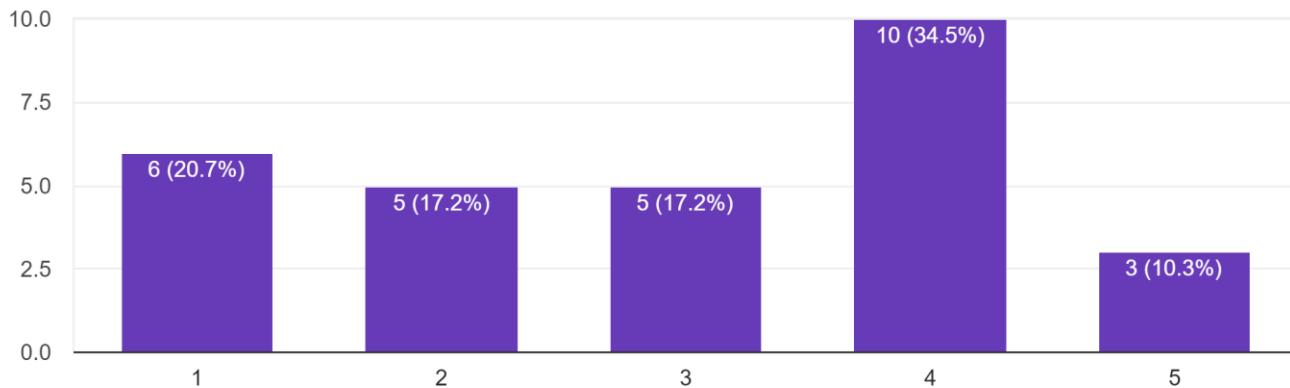
Which aspects of homework/home learning does your child engage with most? Select all that apply.

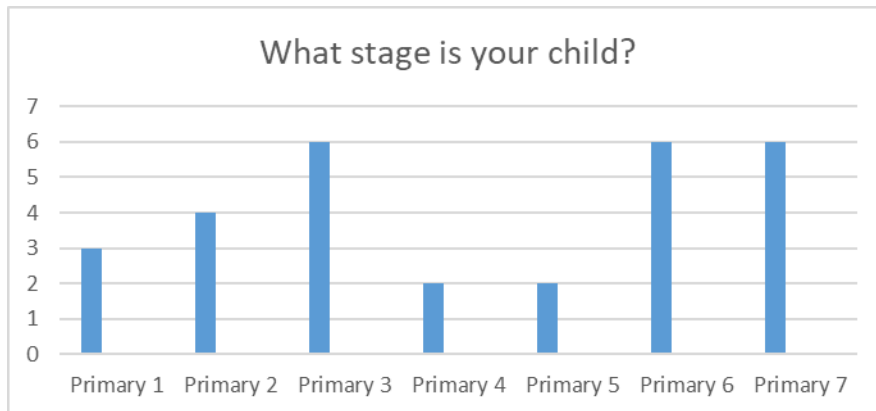
## Breahead Primary School Homework Survey Results

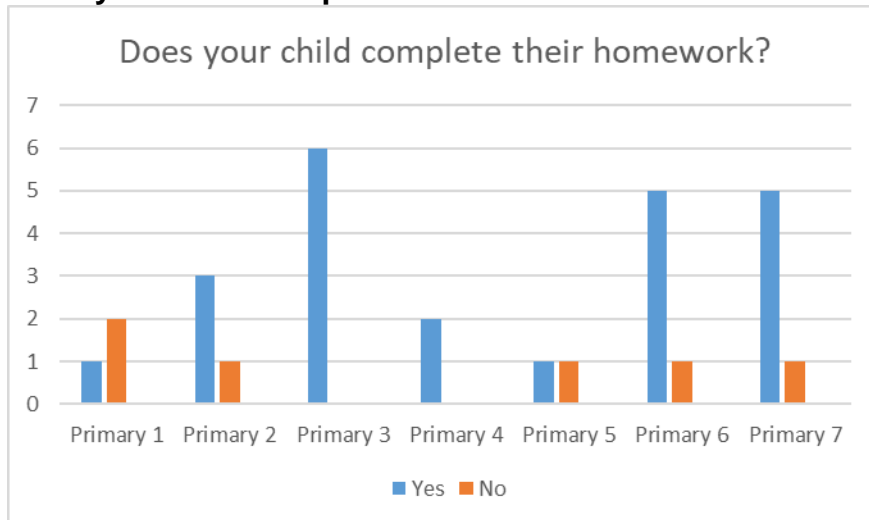

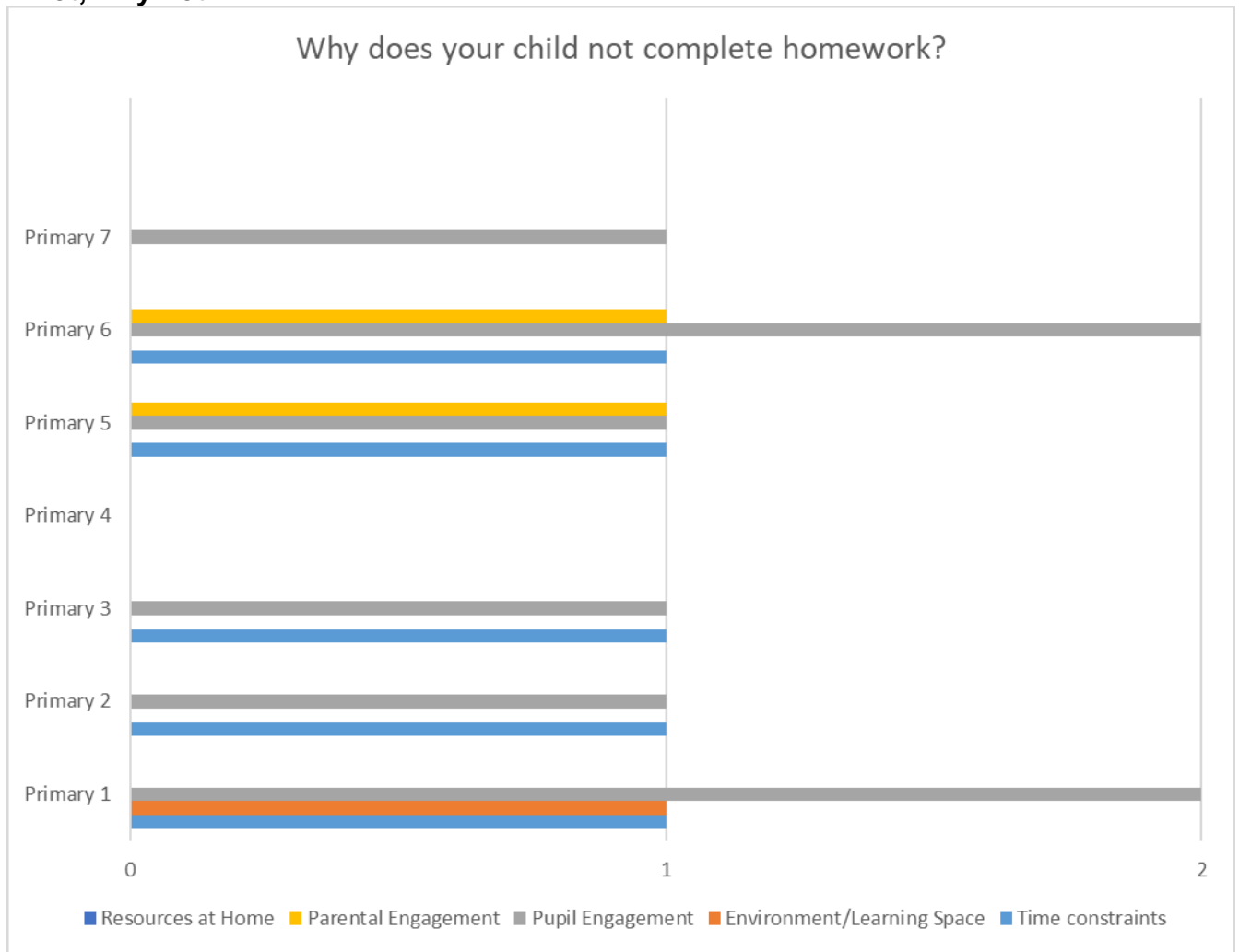

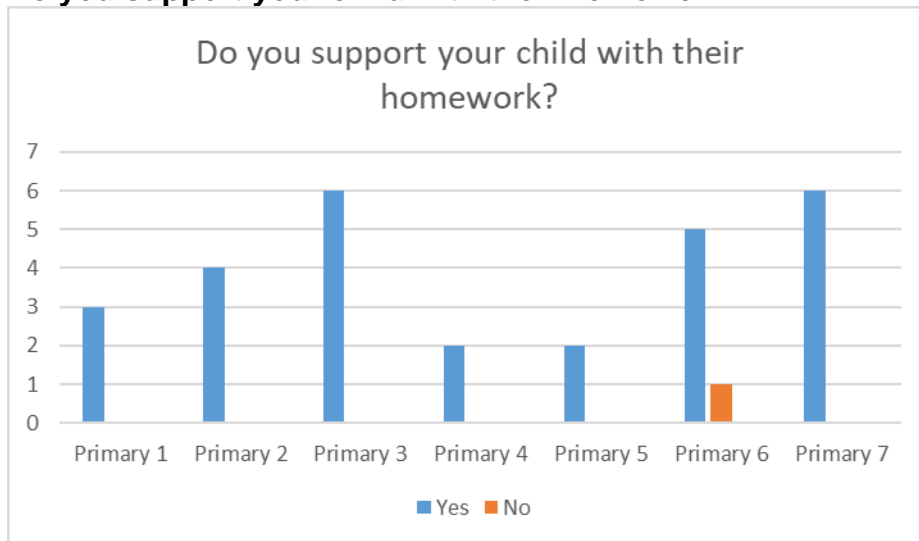
**Does your child complete their homework?**

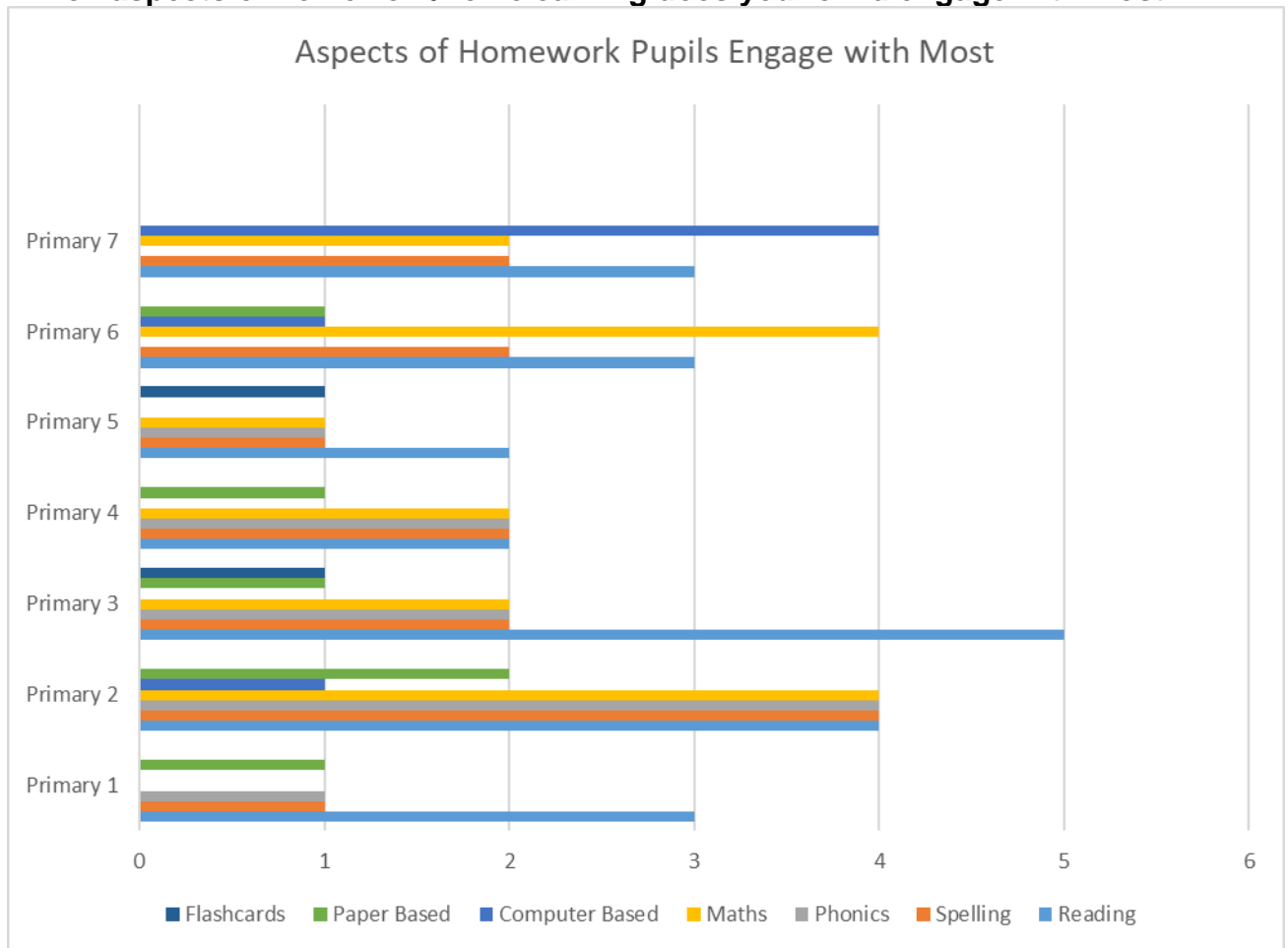

**Do you support your child with their homework?**



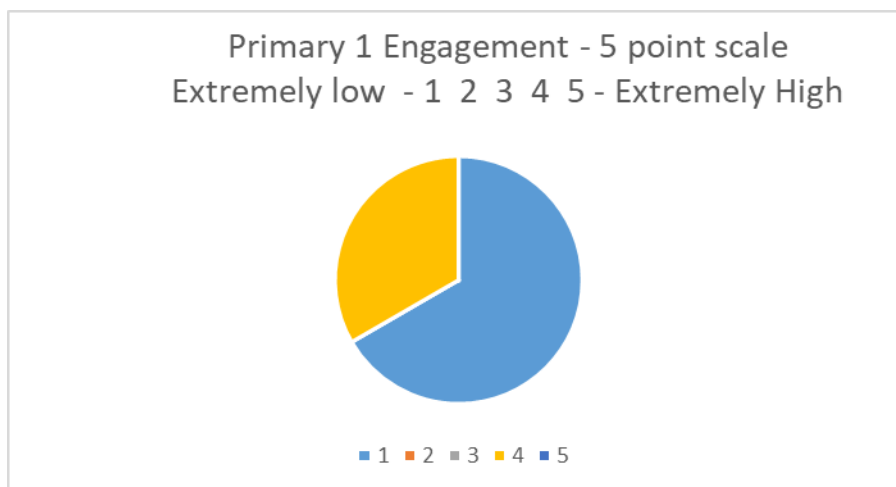

Survey Findings:

- ❖ This does not reflect our whole school environment; 18% of pupils are not represented in this survey.
- ❖ The majority of pupils in the school complete homework.

- ❖ Almost all parents support their children with homework.
- ❖ The greatest percentage of pupils not completing homework is at Primary 1 stage.
- ❖ Pupil engagement is the greatest reason why homework is not completed.
- ❖ Reading is most popular in the lower stages of the primary school.
