### **Scottish Government National Child Online Safety Campaign**

The Scottish Government recently launched its national Child Online Safety campaign. The campaign aims to increase awareness of the importance of online safety to parents and carers of children aged 8–11-year-olds and reassure and inform them that the skills they apply offline to help keep their children safe can be used to protect them online too. The campaign provides practical advice for parents and guardians on how to check and monitor their child's online activity by speaking regularly about online safety and taking an interest in what they do online; discussing and agreeing boundaries; setting safety measures. The campaign also provides clear signposting for parents and children towards additional support.

The campaign includes Digital TV and radio coverage, social media activity, website advertising, and press coverage.
