### **COVID-19**

Most Covid mitigations are no longer required, although South Lanarkshire Council is still emphasising the need for 'Covid sense'.

- Testing for the general population and most contact tracing ended on 30<sup>th</sup> April.
- Adults who have symptoms of Covid-19 or a fever should stay at home until the fever has passed. They do not need to take a PCR test.
- South Lanarkshire Council no longer require staff to test twice weekly.
- Although masks are no longer mandatory South Lanarkshire Council strongly recommend those over 12 years old should still wear them indoors or on public transport.
- NHS advice is that, *'If you've tested positive you should follow the revised guidance to stay at home for 3 days if you're 18 years and under, or for 5 days if you're over 18 years. The way that we count these days has changed. Day 1 is the day after you took your test'*.
