# COVID-19 Update

I am delighted to say that there are no new specific covid guidelines at this stage. We continue to maintain high standards of hygiene at all times with an enhanced cleaning programme and regular hand washing and sanitising remains in place throughout the school day.

# Wednesday 17 August

On Wednesday morning pupils should enter the side gate to the back playground as usual where they will be able to play with their friends until the bell rings at 9am or go breakfast club from 8.15 am. **New Primary 1 children should arrive at school for 9am and enter via the front door**. Mrs Straiton will be waiting at the front door to welcome our new Primary 1 children and will then escort them to the classroom to join the class teacher and the P2/3 children.

Please remember parents are not permitted to enter the school playground prior to 9am and they should drop their children off at the top of the side path. Miss Kralik is always present in the playground should your children require any support coming into the playground.

At the end of the school day parents should enter the back playground via the gate at the right hand side of the school.
