# Clubs!

Clubs are about to start over the next few weeks! All clubs will run from 3-4pm in school, so pupils who usually go home on the bus will need to be collected by parents or carers at 4pm. All clubs will be free.

### **Art & Recycling**

We will be starting our Art and Recycling club on Wednesdays from the 7<sup>th</sup> Feb. For this year's project there will be two blocks of 6 sessions from Arty Bits, which has been funded by a grant from Forth and District Development Trust. All children will have an opportunity to participate if they would like, but rather than an older group and a younger group, we are splitting the children into their House Groups. The first block will be for pupils from **Tashieburn** and **Winneyknowe** – do not worry if you are not sure which house your child or children are in. Consent forms will be sent via the portal only to pupils in Tashieburn and Winneyknowe for this block. The Moss and Shodshill will receive their consent forms later in the session and most children should know which house they are in!

#### **Basketball**

Active Schools have managed to secure some basketball sessions for our school with the North Lanarkshire Titans! There will be four sessions for P4-7s starting on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February, then the 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup> February, followed by three sessions for the P1-3s on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> March. Consent forms will be on the Parent Portal next week.

#### **Dance**

Once again, we will be participating in the South Lanarkshire Dance Festival organised by Active Schools. Miss Watson will be running our dance club this year which will culminate in the Dance Festival performance at Lanark Memorial Hall. Dance Club will run on a Tuesday for six weeks starting on the 20<sup>th</sup> February and is open to all pupils in p3-7. The final performance will be on the 27<sup>th</sup> March, parents or carers need to take pupils to the Memorial Hall and will be able to buy tickets for the performance. Pupils can attend dance club even if they are not able to attend the performance, but it is important that we know so that we can adjust the choreography. Consent forms will be on the portal next week!
