Preparations for Christmas

Our trip to see 'A Cracking Christmas Carol' at East Kilbride Village Theatre will take place on Wednesday 18th December 2024. The trip will cost £4 per pupil. We would be grateful if this payment could be made via parentsportal - Thank you. Please ensure that your child wears their full school uniform. We have a good supply of school sweatshirts in various sizes available.

This year the Pantomime is a morning performance, so it is vitally important that pupils attending the Pantomime arrive to school on time. Pupils who are attending the pantomime do not need to bring an additional snack as a small snack will be provided for each child during the interval.

In order to accommodate space for the coaches required to safely transport pupils and staff back from the village theatre there may be limited capacity for car parking at the start of the school day. We would appreciate, where possible, if parents/carers could park outwith the school grounds. Please remind your child of the importance of being a ready, respectful and responsible pupil during our trip to the Pantomine.

If your child uses an inhaler or has any allergies then please ensure that all medication currently in use is handed into the school office and the paperwork giving consent for staff to administer medication, if required, is completed. All medication required by pupils and all emergency contact information will be taken on our trip.


Christmas Show - Singing Hands

Parents/Carers in Playground

Just a reminder to parents/carers who are dropping off their children at the main playground gates: We would appreciate if parents/carers leave their child at the gate and allow their child to walk into the playground on their own. Parents/carers should refrain from walking with their child into the playground. The school janitor is present at the gate so there is no requirement for parents/carers to walk beyond this point.

Smoking within the school grounds

Please be advised that smoking within the school grounds and within your vehicle whilst driving or parked within our school grounds is not permitted. This includes e-cigarettes. We would be grateful if all smokers adhere to this advice in line with South Lanarkshire Policy.

Emergency Closure Planning

In the event of extreme weather conditions, fire or heating failure the school may need to close. Please discuss alternative pick up arrangements with your child.
