Explain the key events and characters of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

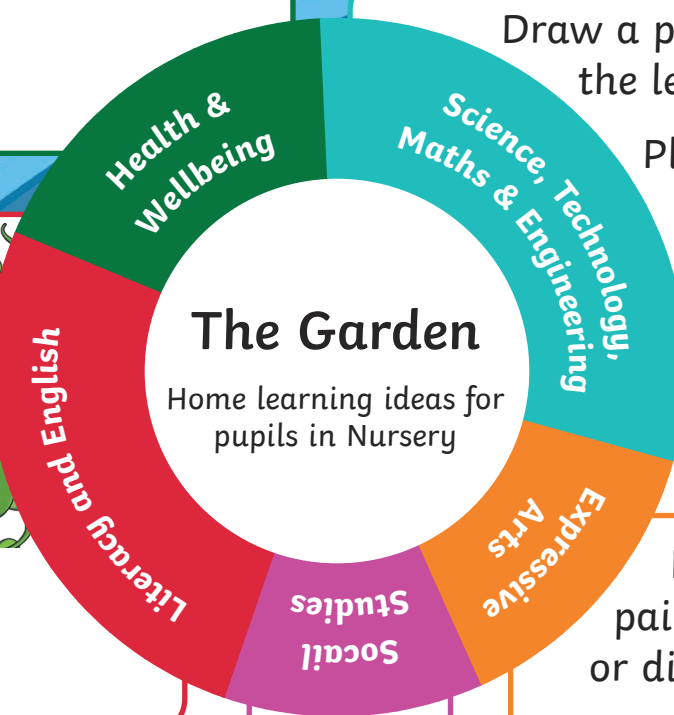
Answer questions about the story.
