

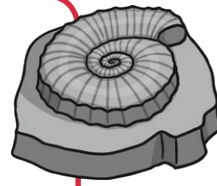
Write a senses poem about the time of the dinosaurs.

Invent a new dinosaur, name it and draw a picture of it.

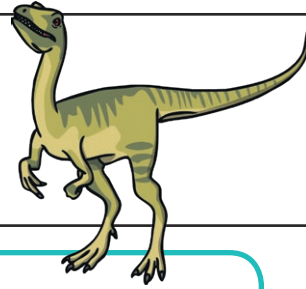
Discuss what I know about dinosaurs and ask questions about what I would like to find out.

Identify types of evidence that tell us about dinosaurs.

Draw a picture of the world when dinosaurs were alive and the world today. What is the same and what is different?

Use playdough, junk or plasticine to create dinosaur models.

Create a 'dinosaur environment' using boxes, stones, twigs, leaves and dinosaur figures or pictures.

Use my voice and my body to show what kind of noises and movements dinosaurs might have made.

Draw a picture of a dinosaur.
