Mrs Moore has joined our school support staff on a part-time permanent basis. Four new school support staff have been appointed and as soon as a start date has been agreed we will be able to recommence our breakfast club as we appreciate that many of our parents rely on this service.

Aiming High Working Together - Meet the Teacher

We are delighted to be able to welcome our parents and carers back into our school building and we will be doing this over two dates one for our mainstream classes Fri 26th August and one for our supported classes Mon 29th August.

In the mainstream sessions you will have an opportunity to visit the classroom, meet the teacher and find out about the learning priorities across the session. Staff will also discuss homework and how to support your child. Each session will last approximately 30 mins and will begin at 1.30 pm or 2.00 pm in our gym hall. Parents will then be collected from the Gym Hall and taken up to class.

Our supported class sessions will take place in the meeting room, and you will be able to meet the class teacher and Mrs Evelyn McGonagle our Youth, Family and Community Learning Officer. The session will last approximately 30 minutes. Please see the time allocated for your child's class.
