Getting It Right For Every Child

We continue to focus on our Covid Recovery with targeted support for children who have gaps in their learning or require emotional wellbeing support. Mrs Stewart will be supporting Rm 18, Rm 17, Rm 15, Rm 14 and Mrs MacDonald is working with Rm 1, Rm 2, Rm 12, Rm 13. We have arranged a Google Meet with our educational psychologist Dr Kelton Greene on Tuesday 15th November at 4.00 pm ... to discuss supporting your child's mental health and wellbeing with a focus on anxiety. Please join us and if you have any particular areas, you would like covered, please let us know. In addition, Mrs Caroline Rice our Specialist Support Teacher will be delivering a parent workshop on supporting your child's literacy, date and time to be confirmed.

Maths Week



During Scottish Maths Week parents/carers are welcome to come into school between 9.10 am and 10.30 to visit the classroom and see maths in action. It is a relaxed informal visit, and you can arrive anytime during the 1hr 20 mins. If you have a few children in the school, you will be able to wander between the classes. We appreciate that it is not always possible to take time off work, but we want to offer as many opportunities for you to visit your child in school as often as possible.
