During these sessions, you will have the opportunity to join in a range of play experiences across the different areas of the nursery as well as having the opportunity to speak to your child's key worker about any concerns you may have.

Rights Respecting

The children have been busy writing their class charter as part of our Rights Respecting. This is displayed above the children's trays in the cloakroom. In the nursery, we focus on 4 articles from The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. These are; Article 7 - the right to a name, Article 19 - the right to be safe, Article 29 - the right to learn and Article 31 - the right to play.

We understand that some children like to bring a small transitional toy from home to show their friends, then keep in their nursery tray. Recently we have had an increase in toys with very small pieces which unfortunately get lost, if possible, could we please limit toys being brought into nursery to avoid any disappointment.
