Points from previous meeting:

Main discussion points from today:

- New members are welcomed and introduced to the Rights Respecting pupil voice group.
- Members are made aware that this pupil voice group is made up of a cross-section of other pupil voice groups to ensure, all pupil voice groups have a say in rights.
