Points from previous meeting:

- The purpose of the Rights Respecting pupil group → To give pupils an opportunity to express their opinions and ideas about how their school can respect and promote rights, as outlined in the UNCRC.
- Discussed the language of rights and where we see this in our school.

- Celebrated our class charters and discussed how to ensure all aspects of charters were included.

- Strengths:

 - All charters had been signed in a unique way by pupils.
- Next steps:
 - Class teachers to ensure all duty bearer responsibilities were displayed on charters.
 - Promoting the language of 'rights holders' and 'duty bearers'

Focus Articles:

Article 1 – Everyone under the age of 18 has all the rights of the convention.

Article 12 – Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and opinions and to have their views considered and taken seriously.

Action Points:
