Points from previous meeting:

- Class charter audits completed.

Main discussion points from today:

- Members are welcomed into the Rights Respecting pupil voice group.
- Members explored right of the month – Article 13: Every child must be free to express their learning, thoughts and opinions and to access all kinds of information, as long as it is within the law.
- Members worked in groups to discuss ways in which they would like to explore article 13 in our school.

 - Pupil group to visit classes and ask if anyone would like to share learning, thoughts or feelings with them.

Focus Articles:

Article 1 – Everyone under the age of 18 has all the rights of the convention.

Article 12 – Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and opinions and to have their views considered and taken seriously.

Article 13: Every child must be free to express their learning, thoughts and opinions and to access all kinds of information, as long as it is within the law.
