Points from previous meeting:

- Ambassadors welcomed and reminded of their integral role in the Gold RRS reaccreditation.
- Reviewed and celebrated existing rights work: assemblies, classroom visits, display articles, class charter checks, and Together Time activities.
- Planned an October Rights Scavenger Hunt to explore a wide range of rights across the school.
- Focus on Articles 12, 13, 15, 29, and 42.
- <u>Action</u>: To complete new class charter checks and provide feedback on the upcoming rights journey (completed)

Main discussion points from today:

- Rights Respecting Ambassadors shared their experiences creating classroom charters and explored examples showing how charters help pupils understand how to respect rights and the responsibilities of duty bearers.
- Ambassadors discussed the ABCDE of Rights resource used during Rights
 Hour and suggested always having access to it to support peers in
 understanding their rights.
- Miss Jamieson explained that Ambassadors would play a key role in the school's reaccreditation process and that they would be meeting more frequently to discuss and share their ideas about what should be included.

Actions Taken

- Ambassadors visited all classrooms to complete class charter checks and provided feedback to Miss Jamieson.
