## Literacy and Numeracy – Providing a rich and stimulating Curriculum that helps raise standards in Literacy and Numeracy

- ✓ Further develop and embed Talk for Writing throughout the school
- ✓ Complete audit for Reading School Gold Award and begin work
- ✓ Improve communication skills by continuing Makaton within the nursery with the Nursery children coming into the school to support the school.
- ✓ Teaching staff will receive updated numeracy pedagogy training in line with the authorities approach to reduce the attainment gap. Mrs Ferguson will be leading on this.
- ✓ Introduce Numicon resources and opportunities to use them in the nursery
- ✓ Outdoor learning opportunities to be used regularly to enhance Literacy and Numeracy Teaching and Learning
- ✓ Parent Workshops to enhance literacy and numeracy support at home.

## Equity – Ensuring inclusion, equity and equality are at the heart of what we do:

- ✓ Support families to increase attendance rates.
- ✓ School support staff to be timetabled to work with targeted children
- ✓ Plan appropriate 1:1 and small group interventions with intervention teachers (Mrs Ferguson - Numeracy, Ms Kelly - Literacy) in order to close the attainment gap.
- ✓ Increase outdoor learning opportunities to support knowledge and skills as well as team work.
- ✓ Work with pupils and parents to plan and spend PB.
- ✓ Cost of the School Day Policy to be written.



## Developing the Young Workforce – supporting children and young people to develop their skills for learning, life and work:

- ✓ Use of SLC Key skills during outdoor education and as part of the new SLC Developing the Young Workforce Framework
- ✓ In the nursery we will be introducing woodworking sessions for all learners, developing a progressive skills framework as we go.
