Assemblies and Achievements



We have P1-3 and P4-7 assemblies every Friday afternoon. We are a Rights Respecting School and during this time we talk to the children about their rights and how we respect each others' rights, through themes such as friendship, bullying, respect, behaviour expectations, values, citizenship, etc. We also celebrate success both in and out of school at assembly. Each week, class teachers choose a pupil demonstrating 'The High Blantyre Way' as Star of the Week, which is presented at assembly. Head Teacher Awards are presented at our monthly celebration assembly for outstanding work. Children are also encouraged to bring in achievements from home, e.g: swimming badges, medals, certificates, etc to our monthly achievement assembly, which is held on the last Friday of every month. We sometimes have visitors to our assemblies. including our school Chaplain, Mr Jim Murphy, who comes to talk to the children about school assembly themes, values, Christian festivals and other World Religions.
