### Safe use of the Drop off area



Thank you for your support in using the drop off area at the start and end of the school day safely. Can we kindly remind parents/carers to drive slowly in this area and not park on the double yellow lines. Once the spaces are filled up at the bottom car park, this should only be used as a drop off area first thing in the morning. There should be a constant flow of traffic leaving the school at the end of the day and once the spaces are filled, no cars should be stopping or parking, unless a space becomes available. We kindly ask that cars do not park on the zebra crossing. The Health and Safety of all our children is our main priority. The staff car park should not be used by parents/carers for drop off at breakfast club, first thing in the morning or at the end of the day. If you have a blue disabled badge and need to access the school at these busy times, please inform the school office, who will give you a blue school badge to display on the dashboard of your car. Once our ASN transport has left and it is safe to do so, our janitor will let you in to park in a disabled space. This is all part of our School Traffic Management Plan as agreed by Health and Safety. We encourage all our High Blantyre families to walk/park and stride to school nursery where possible. It is against the law to park on the zig zag lines outside of the school and our community police drop by at times to monitor the local situation.
