Pupil Safety



Unfortunately, we continue to have concerns with regards to pupil safety at drop off and pick up times, especially when it rains! Please can we kindly remind parents/carers of both school and nursery children that the staff car park is for **staff only**. Blue badge holders can access the disabled spaces at drop off and pick up times if required, **after** our ASN transport has left. If you have a blue badge, please show this to our school office and they will give you a school pass to display in your car. This will enable our janitor to easily identify cars permitted to enter the car park at these exceptionally busy times.

Unfortunately, there has been several incidents over the past few weeks where our janitor has been verbally abused by parents/carers at drop off and pick up times in front of children and their families. This is unacceptable and no one should have to experience this type of behaviour whilst at work and following procedures to ensure the safety of our children.

We would also like to encourage our children to walk, cycle, etc to school, where possible, to reduce the amount of cars around the school and parking in residential areas at drop off and pick up times. Unfortunately, some of our parents/carers are parking on zig zag lines outside Carrigans at these busy times, which is extremely dangerous. We have asked the community to police to help support us with this situation. We love seeing our children using our outdoor gym, which our Parent Council gifted the school. A kind reminder that the outdoor gym should not be used before school and children must be accompanied across the zebra crossing by an adult at the end of the day, to ensure their safety at this busy time! Please help us keep our children safe as they travel to and from school.
