

30 Second Scripted Information

- Gentle approach, personal, non-threatening, side on, eye level or lower.
- State the behaviour that was observed, and which rule/expectation/routine was disregarded.
- Tell the learner what the consequence of their action is e.g. who it is affecting and how. Refer to previous good behaviour/learning as a model for the desired behaviour and say, 'Thank you for listening'.
- Leave the learner; allow him/her time to decide what to do next.
- If there are comments, as you walk away – do not react or respond. Write them down and follow up later.

We resist endless discussions around behaviour and spend our energy returning learners to their learning

Restorative Questions

- What happened?
- What were you feeling/thinking at the time?
- How did this make others feel?
- What has been affected and how?
- What could we do to put things right?
- If this happened again, how could we do things differently?
