The nights are drawing in and there is certainly a nip in the air. We hope you are all keeping safe and well as we head towards the festive season.

Dressing for the weather

Our children are continuing with their outdoor learning in all weathers, we have our own warm jackets and wellies the children can wear when in Nursery to enable them all to access the outdoor area. If you have not already done so, please provide your child with a couple of spare changes of clothes to be kept in their nursery peg bags. We also ask that you label all your child's clothing, especially jumpers and cardigans.

Planning Ahead for Inclement Weather

Those of you who have lived in Strathaven for some time will be aware that the weather here can deteriorate with travel conditions becoming exceedingly difficult quite quickly.

Should the weather deteriorate, any decision to keep the school and nursery closed prior to 9am will be communicated via any mode that is accessible to us. Please note that this is dependent on where we are (i.e. if we are stuck on the roads, we may not be able to access these). This will include the school app, learning journal, school, and council websites. It is also likely to be announced on local radio.

Please be aware that on some occasions a decision may be made to defer opening until 10am. This happens when the Council anticipates that staff will be able to get to school and nursery, but it may take longer than usual due to weather conditions.

Often the roads around Strathaven become grid-locked when there is heavy snow. A decision to defer opening can happen quite late as the situation can change very rapidly. This can be up to 8.30am if staff are stuck in the surrounding roads.

If in the lead up to 10am the situation changes and it becomes apparent that the weather is declining further or staff are unable to get to school and nursery, further communication will be sent out via the modes outlined above (which can be accessed).

It may be necessary to close the school and nursery at short notice during the school day if the weather takes a significant turn for the worse.

If this happens, we will contact you by sending out a message on the school app, learning journal and by telephone. Please note that the only other official sources of information would be from South Lanarkshire Council themselves or via the local radio or news.

If the school and nursery are closed mid-way through the day, we will not release children unless collected by an adult. Please make your way to the nursery as safely and quickly as possible. Should you be some distance away we would be most appreciative if you could arrange for a friend, neighbour, or family member to collect and care for your child until you get home. This will enable our staff to make their way home safely too. Please phone to let us know if you have authorised somebody other than yourself to collect your child.

It is essential that we have the correct contact phone numbers, please let us know if there have been any changes.

Lunch ordering

The children's lunch orders must be delivered each morning to the kitchen by 9.30am. If your child is arriving later than this to nursery, we ask that you contact us ahead of their arrival to advise us of their order to ensure it is included.

We are looking forward to the P.T.A Christmas Fair on **Tuesday 2nd December**, doors will open at 6.30pm. There are lots of fantastic stalls ranging from children's enterprise crafts to Tombola and Raffles.
