Spotlight on Learning



We are putting a spotlight on vocabulary every month and we will include our focus words at the end of each newsletter, please look and consider using these words at home to promote vocabulary acquisition.

Research shows that children need to hear a word many, many times before they will start to use it themselves and that having a wide vocabulary will help support future academic progress. We have carefully selected words that we hope will help the children learn more about their world.

We are only able to have 6-8 families per session, if the response is greater than this number, we will draw the names out of a hat. Families that are unsuccessful will be offered the opportunity to attend a second block of sessions in April/May.

Primary One Registration



If your child is due to start Primary One in August 2023, you must register them for school this month. School registration forms will be available on South Lanarkshire Council's website from Monday 8th January. Schools will begin to contact families from Monday 15th January 2024, after the online forms have been completed. Parents/carers will need their child's **full** birth certificate and **two** proofs of address in the name of the **parent/carer completing the registration documents**.
