Every child will be chosen to be a VIP several times throughout the year, giving everyone in nursery an opportunity to celebrate their unique qualities.

In line with the whole school, we are updating our self-registration to include our new emotional check-in with key workers. Our new emotional check-in is aimed at helping our team to enhance our health and wellbeing programme.

#### Packed Lunches

A reminder that our school is a nut free zone, please do not send any nuts with packed lunches including chocolate bars and spreads that contain nuts.

We ask that if you are giving your children grapes in their packed lunch that they are quartered, in line with guidance from the Care Inspectorate.

Care Inspectorate have also advised that carrot batons are chopped up and that raisins are not given. These requests are made to avoid choking hazards.

Care Inspectorate have also requested that children having packed lunches have a cool pack in their box to keep food fresh. We can provide these for any child who does not have one.

School App

We are encouraging all our families to have the Kirktonholme Primary School App. Our App details are available from the school office and nursery. We use our App to give notifications to families e.g. school news, celebrations, late start due to snow, events, etc.

## Clothing Grant for 3 and 4 year olds.

Children aged 3 and 4 who meet the eligibility criteria will get a clothing grant, which is currently £130 per child, per year. Most families that are eligible will be automatically provided with the grant based on information held by the team at benefits and revenue, however parents can also apply.
