Our school car park continues to be an area of significant challenge for both you as parents and us as the school team. We must work together to keep our children safe. Please try to use other means of travel to school or alternative dropping off or collecting points, avoiding the car park and Dornoch Place where possible. In the morning the car park is available for drop off only and children must use the pavements. Do NOT allow your child to exit on the driver's side. Please be prepared for congestion delays if you choose to enter Dornoch Place. The only parents allowed to park in our car park are nursery parents and families in possession of a blue badge. Blue badge owners should have contacted the school in advance providing evidence of their status. I appreciate the frustrations some of you have experienced using the car park and my advice is to plan ahead and make alternative arrangements.
