
Primary One Registration ^J

If your child is due to start Primary One in August 2025, you must register them for school. School registration forms will be available on South Lanarkshire Council's website from Monday 6th January. Schools will begin to contact families from Monday 13th January 2024, after the online forms have been completed. Parents/carers will need their child's full birth certificate and two proofs of address in the name of the parent/carer completing the registration documents. If you would like to discuss any aspect of school registration, please speak with Mrs Wright or Mrs Clow.

Early Learning Class Applications The <u>closing date for Early Learning</u> <u>Class applications is 28/02/25</u>. If you have a child or know of a child due to start nursery during session 2025/26, an application form should be completed by the closing date of 28/02/25. Please telephone the school office for an appointment to complete an application form.

Any family wishing to make a transfer request for next session should request the form from Mrs Clow or Mrs Moran.

Spotlight on Learning

We are continuing to put a spotlight on vocabulary every month and we will include our focus words at the end of each newsletter, please look and consider using these words at home to promote vocabulary acquisition. Research shows that children need to hear a word many, many times before they will start to use it themselves and that having a wide vocabulary will help support future academic progress. We have carefully selected words that we hope will help the children learn more about their world.
