This literacy opportunity builds upon our previous spotlight on vocabulary initiative.

As a team we strive to ensure that families feel well informed about all aspects of nursery life. We aim to do this through; monthly newsletters, regular feedback requests, notices on the nursery door, displays, stay and play sessions, telephone calls with a member of the leadership team prior to your child starting, daily contact with staff, parents' evenings, invitations to events, our school app, school website, etc. If there is any aspect of your child's learning and development that you would like to know more about or share with us, please speak to the team.
