#### Focus



If your child is due to start Primary One in August 2026, you will have to register them for their local school from week beginning Monday 5th January. The enrolment form should be completed on South Lanarkshire Council's website. You will need your child's full birth certificate and two proofs of address, dated within the last six months, in the name of the adult completing the enrolment form. If Kirktonholme Primary School is your catchment school, we will be in touch to give you some information about starting school once you have completed the online enrolment form.
