## **Uniform, Gym Shoes & PE Kit**

As a school we have very high standards and expect all pupils to come to school prepared for the day ahead.

Recently we have become increasingly concerned with the number of children who are not wearing their school uniform. Our uniform consists of; grey trousers/skirt, white polo shirt/shirt & tie and grey or green jumper. School joggers can also be worn but this should only be on PE days. Tracksuits/leggings/jeans/coloured t-shirts are not part of our uniform and are not acceptable to be worn.

There are also a large number of children who do not have gym shoes (or are not wearing them in class). **ALL** children must have a pair of gym shoes to wear in school. This is to stop the spread of mud and dirt through the school, to wear for gym/drama sessions but also in case your child's feet get wet, there is nothing worse than sitting all day with wet feet. As a school we are unable to have spare shoes for pupils.

Please ensure your child has a **full** PE kit on gym days, it is also beginning to get cold and <u>ALL</u> classes have an outdoor PE Block each week, therefore all children should have suitable outdoor PE kit. Please remember all long hair <u>MUST</u> be tied back and all jewellery removed. Appropriate PE kit is a South Lanarkshire and a Health & Safety requirement. Not having kit is not an excuse for not participating in PE, pupils should have a note from their parents, or in extreme cases of non-participation, their doctor.

If you are unable to provide your child with a uniform, gym shoes or PE kit, please contact the school and we can support you as best we can.

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# **Norovirus (Winter Vomiting Bug)**

As part of this year's NHS norovirus seasonal awareness campaign, NHS Health Scotland has developed a matt laminated poster and supporting public information leaflet. Please note to avoid spreading this virus amongst our school community, all pupils with sickness and diarrhoea should stay home for 48 hours after symptoms end. If children return to school before the 48 hours have passed, we will contact you to come and collect your child again.

When children complain of being unwell in school, we will use our professional opinion when deciding on the best course of action, however we are not health care professionals and if we are in any doubt will call parents/carers or emergency contacts for children to be collected and apologise if this causes any inconvenience. We will always act in what we believe is your child's best interest.

#### **Adverse Weather Plan**

In the event of heavy snow fall, the Adverse Weather Plan will be implemented. This has been developed by SLC Facility Services to take account of safe systems of work for Janitorial staff working in extreme weathers.

- The HT will make the decision that the Adverse Weather plan is to be implemented and inform parents/carers via Twitter and text message (if possible).
- The janitor will unlock the gates at the car park entrance only.
- The janitor will create a safe pathway from the gate to the main entrance and ensure all fire doors are clear.
- All pupils and staff will enter via the Main Entrance.
- No other gates will be opened and there will be no access paths created in the playground.
- Local weather conditions will be monitored and parents/carers will be kept informed via Twitter and text message.
- In the event of the school being closed or your child being unable to attend school we will provide winter weather work. This will be posted on the school website as well as Twitter.

We thank you for your co-operation and understanding in the event of any weather-related disruption. All decisions taken will be in the best interest of pupils and staff.
