- Review our relationships policy.
- Develop a working party (ideally with staff from all stages).
- Enhance and support staff wellbeing.
- Building staff capacity (updating staff, continuous training opportunities, provide time to feedback and reflect).
- Continue to inform parents and provide opportunities for parental engagement.
- Revise our self regulation and nurture areas.

I have included the list of attachment/nurture texts available to rent from SLC, so if anyone wishes to do any further reading, please let me know and I can contact the specialist support team. A big thank you to Alan H, who has kindly donated some of his books to the staffroom for you to use for your own CLPL or within your classrooms. I will add some of the texts I have to our ever growing resource bank and if anyone else wishes to pop their books too, please feel free as it would be much appreciated.

I have also created a folder in the Staff SharePoint with all resources from the SLC Staff Learning Centre and the Attachment Network Group Google Classroom. I will continue to send regular updates from these meetings via email and then add any further documents to the shared folders.
