School Improvement Plan

There are a number of significant improvements we are making this year as we continue to build an excellent school and ELC.
Our priorities are:

- VCPA Maths and Numeracy approaches
- Writing Moderation
- STEM
- Learning for Sustainability

Upcoming Projects and Initiatives

VCPA

Staff are taking part in VCPA maths and numeracy training through SLC and are beginning to build the related resources and teaching approaches within their classrooms. In partnership with staff, Miss Vickers is building Law Primary School's Numeracy Strategy.

STEM

We are in the process of auditing our STEM resources to create a STEM room to support science, technology, computing science and digital literacy.

Writing Moderation

Alongside schools and nurseries in Carluke Learning Community and Carluke High school, we are creating a shared planner to help assess and support the teaching of writing from nursery to high school.

Learning for Sustainability

Our school community are aware of the UNCRC and children's rights. All pupils are participating in global citizenship and sustainability projects. We are working towards our silver Rights Respecting Schools award.

Christmas Support
