MATHS AND NUMERACY	LITERACY	HEALTH & WELLBEING
<p>Time – We will be learning to read and record time in both 12 hour and 24 hour notation and to convert between the two. We will be learning to calculate durations of activities and events bridging across several and parts of hours using 12 hour clock and 24 hour notation. We will learn to calculate speed, distance and time.</p> <p>Multiples and Factors – we will be learning about multiples, factors and primes, and how to use these when solving problems in number, money and measure.</p> <p>Mental Maths – we will continue to use the four operations, working with decimal fractions.</p>	<p>We are reading together the whole class novel 'Divided City' by Theresa Breslin. We are also reading non-fiction and fiction texts in our reading groups. Through these books we are re-visiting the NLC reading strategies. We will continue to practise our fiction and non-fiction writing skills. In Spelling we will continue to use NLC spelling strategies and will continue to work on spelling rules and common words as well as topic words.</p> <p>We will explore the Scots' language and develop our understanding of this through stories and poetry.</p>	<p>With Mrs Lavery we are learning about Anti-social Behaviour and the Law, as well as Drugs and Alcohol to support informed and responsible choices.</p> <p>With Mrs Gibson, we are learning strategies to help us build resilience and face new challenges positively. We are using a resource called 'Think To Thrive' to do this.</p>

LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM
RME - Sense Over Sectarianism (SOS) – we will learn tolerance and respect through a series of lessons about Sectarianism and prejudice. We will also take part in a digital art competition, as part of SOS.
STEM – we will continue to develop our STEM skills by taking part in design challenges and using the design process.
We look forward to a visit this term from Scottish Water. We will take part in a lesson titled 'Generation H2O'. We will learn about saving water and clean water. This links to our work on The Sustainable Development Global Goals.
LEGO – we look forward to a future visit this term from Skills Development Scotland. We will use Lego to learn more about wind farms and sustainable energy production through this session.
Art – we will explore the concept of depth by creating a foreground, a middle ground and a background in a picture.
Music – we will explore using technology (Google Chrome Music Lab) to create music, experimenting tuned/untuned percussion instruments to create simple melodies and rhythms.
Scotland – throughout January, we will take part in a focus on Scotland. We will look at Scots' vocabulary through poetry and stories. We will research famous a famous Scot and complete a factfile. We will explore Scottish tartan and using mixed media, create our own. We will also learn to sing and perform a Scottish song for our Burns celebration.
