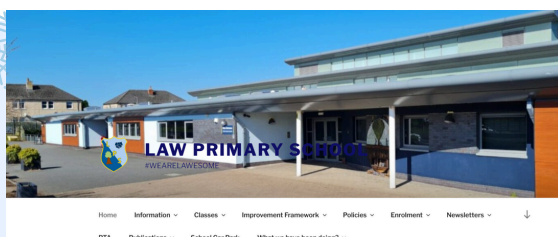
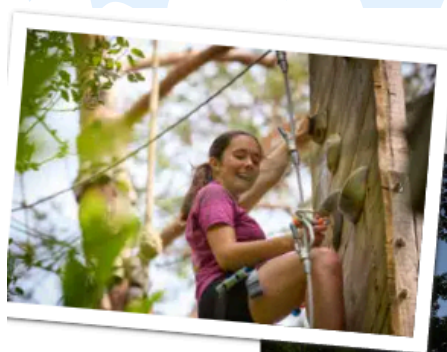
## Primary 7 Residential
