<p>We will be learning...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To multiply and divide using various strategies To identify multiples of whole numbers Investigate patterns between tables to 10x table To read 12-hour times on analogue and digital clocks and calculate how long an activity has taken 	<p>We will be learning...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spelling – Children will be learning to recognise and spell common words, spelling rules and phonemes using varied active strategies. Reading – Children will be developing skills in predicting, summarising, comprehension and inference with texts corresponding to their book band. <p>We will also be exploring poetry</p> <p>Writing – Children will be focusing on writing instructions and explanations for non-fiction texts and will be learning about settings and different openings and endings in fiction writing.</p>	<p>We will be learning...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stereotypes and how incorrect assumptions can be made that can affect each other. Emotion works and talking about our feelings and strategies to deal with our emotions in a positive way. In our outdoor PE slot, we will be focusing on Orienteering and teamwork. This allows us to work on our meta skills such as communication and cooperation. In indoor PE we will be playing target games through the sports bocchia, bowling and curling
