

BOY ATTACKED by MASTIFF...

A ten-year-old boy is recovering in hospital

after being savaged by a bull mastiff just a few miles from where a youngster was killed by the same breed of dog. Mark Davison was playing with friends in a garden near his home in Stockton-on-Tees, when the chained-up dog broke free.

The boy's mother said: "The dog flung itself at Mark and knocked him over, then began attacking him. The father of the family who own the dog saw what was happening and ran to help. He pulled the dog off and it turned on him, biting him on the arm. The father called the police and ambulance and had the dog destroyed straight away."

Mark, who has cuts and bruises on his arms, face and chest, is recovering in Middlesbrough General Hospital.
