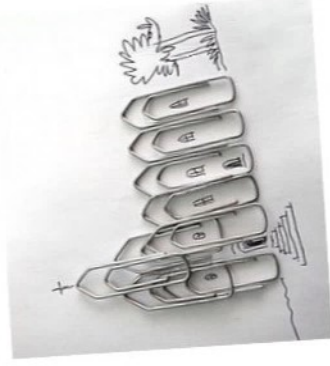
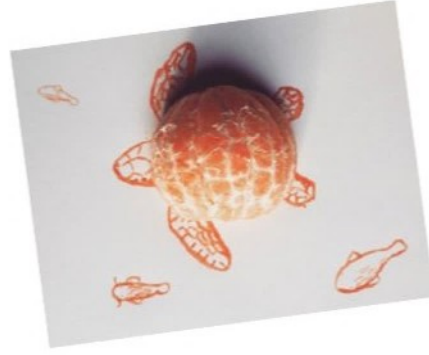
Finding Inspiration
