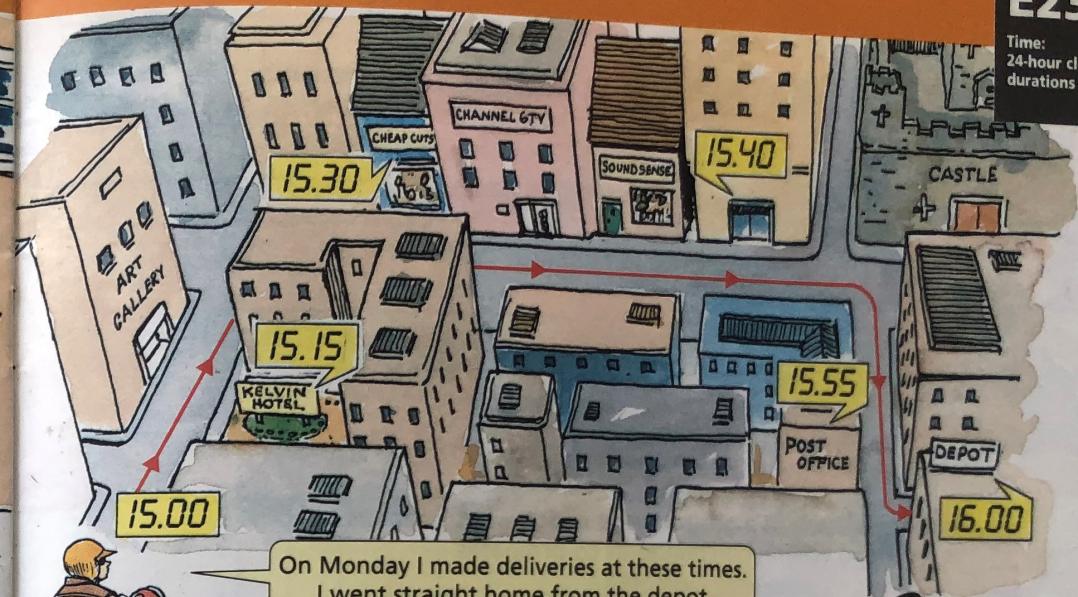


I went into Sound Sense just before 3 o'clock. I arrived home for the evening at half past four.

On Monday I made deliveries at these times. I went straight home from the depot.

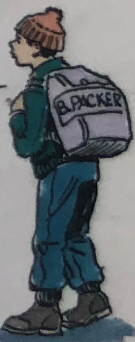
I was in the studio audience for 5 1/4 hours. I arrived at the studios at 11.50.
