### **World Book Day Information – Thursday 2nd March 2023**

At Murray Primary School we always celebrate World Book Day in a BIG way. Our school and nursery look forward to celebrating World Book Day once again on **Thursday 2nd March 2023**.

All children and staff are invited to come to school and Nursery dressed in their pyjamas with a teddy and a book. Onesies, 'oodies' and dressing gowns are all acceptable. Children may wish to change when they get to school or have leggings and vests on underneath. Or alternatively, children can come in dressed up in World Book Day costumes.

*Please note there is no cost for this day.*

There will be a huge range of activities and events taking place on and around World Book Day including:

- **Donate a Book** – everyone is asked to donate a second-hand book to our classroom libraries. Donations of fiction or non-fiction books, comics etc are most welcome.
- **Big Booky Breakfast (8.15am – 8.45am)** – bring a book to share at the Breakfast Club. All parents and carers of children who attend the Breakfast Club are invited to come along and share a book with their child with a bite to eat.
- **Room 4 World Book Day Assembly (9.30am)** – Room 4 parents and carers are invited to attend Room 4's World Book Day whole school and Nursery Assembly.
- **Reading Buddies Spiral** – children will be paired up with their reading buddy and read with them in the gym hall in the shape of a spiral. Whole school photo will be taken and will be shared on twitter.
- **In-Class Activities** – children will take part in various reading themed activities in their classrooms such as 'guess the book title - emoji quiz', design a book token competition and scavenger hunts.
- **Reading Masterclass** – children will have the opportunity to go to another class and hear a different teacher read a popular story and then complete a fun activity linked to the story.
- **World Book Day Tokens** – look out for your child's token in their bag on World Book Day. Details of how to use the token are printed on it.

We hope this year's World Book Day will be lots of fun and will encourage everyone to read more!
