Our school playground is supervised by school staff from 8.45am to 9.00am every day. We expect pupils to arrive in school in plenty of time for a 9.00am start.

Parents and carers play a vital role in ensuring their child arrives at school on time.

Punctuality is essential for pupils to achieve their full educational potential and is an important life skill which will establish good habits and routines for our pupils both now and in the future.

At Murray Primary School we provide a Breakfast Club service from 8.15am to 8.45am daily during term-time. This is free for all to attend and there is no need to book.

We are closely monitoring punctuality in order to raise standards, and we will contact families if your child/children are regularly late. Our aim is to work in partnership with families to support improvements in punctuality.
