Literacy

Phonics - we will complete the Active Literacy Programme by learning their stage 2 phonemes. There are a few consolidation weeks towards the end of the term to revise all phonemes learned throughout the year. We will continue to learn a new weekly phoneme with four common words this term.

Reading - we will be learning to make notes under certain headings as well as study the features of both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will continue to read our individual and group readers, focussing on expression and comprehension skills.

Talking and listening - we will participate in group discussions. We will be encouraged to listen respectfully and ask suitable questions. We will also use our notes to help us discuss different topics.

Writing – our focus this term is recount writing. We will develop our skills in this by looking at the different features of functional recounts and produce pieces linked to our topic. Mrs Smith will also be developing Talk for Writing strategies with the class.

Numeracy

We will continue to participate in our mental maths activities and out CLIC sessions daily. We will aim to develop accuracy and speed when performing mental calculations.

Squares

- Explore expressions and equations.
- Learn subtraction facts from 16-20.
- Develop our understanding of money.
- Investigate symmetry in 2D shapes.

Circles

- Addition and subtraction within 100.
- Exploring 3D shapes.
- Compass directions and pathways.
- Working with money to £10.

Triangles

- Doubling 2digit multiples of 10.
- Revising addition and subtraction, odd and even and numbers to 100.
- Begin to explore the 2 times table.
- Develop our understanding of money.
