Literacy

Phonics

One new phoneme will be introduced each Monday and we will practise these daily using a variety of active approaches. We will revise previously covered phonemes periodically.

Reading

We will continue to develop reading fluency and how punctuation can help us to read with expression. We will read book banded books individually, in pairs and in groups.

Talking and Listening

We will continue to participate in group and class discussions on a variety of topic. We will develop our skills in asking and answering questions.

Writing

Mrs Smith will deliver a taught writing lesson weekly. We will make use of short burst. The children will continue to develop their use of VCOP skills within written work.

The children will be developing their grammar and handwriting on a weekly basis.

Numeracy

This term, we will cover:

Addition-

adding two digit numbers.

Subtraction-

Subtracting two digit numbers, linking addition and subtraction facts.

Multiplication-

2, 3 and 4 times tables using repeated addition and skip counting.

Division-

Dividing by 2, 3 and 4 using repeated subtraction and skip counting.

Weight-

Ways to measure weight, reading scales and estimating grams and kilograms.

Estimating & Rounding-

Estimating numbers to 20 and rounding to nearest 10 or 100.

Data Handling-

Conducting a survey, bar charts, pictograms and using digital technology.

Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for term 2 will be on exploring topics and activities relating to our food and health. We will be looking at different food groups and creating a balanced diet. We will also discuss importance of daily hygiene.
