Literacy

Phonics

We are continuing with the Active Literacy phonics programme.

Jellybeans

Each week the children will be introduced to a new phoneme and 4 common words. Every 2/3 weeks there will be a consolidation week. The children will complete active spelling tasks.

Lollipops

Will continue to introduce joined phonemes covering one new one a week. They will also have 4 common words each week.

Reading

The children will continue to have a weekly home reader as well as one differentiated group books per week. The children will work on this text for 3/4 days to aid their comprehension and read to write skills. The children will be learning strategies to work out tricky words and to help them develop a deeper understanding of what they are reading.

Writing

The children will be continuing to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces in their writing.

They will continue to follow the Talk 4 Writing scheme covering a range of stories that allow us to dive into how a writer writes different genres.

Numeracy

This term we will be learning:

Squares

2 times table

Halves and quarters

Using o'clock and half past

Following directions – forward, back, left and right

Circles

Subtraction facts to 10

Counting on and back to 30

Comparing and ordering

Sequencing numbers

We will also be further developing our mental maths skills through completing daily challenges and a variety of mental maths games.

Technology

We will be learning how to add pictures into our work, change the shape and position of it then save it under a specific name.

PE

We will be developing

Science

We will be exploring living things and the impact on our environment and life these have.

Showcase

We will be practising and performing our Showcase with a chance to see all our wonderful topic work.
