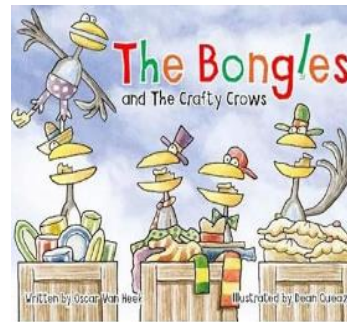
In the book all the Bongles look different but can you spot what features are the same?
