Increased attainment in writing throughout the school

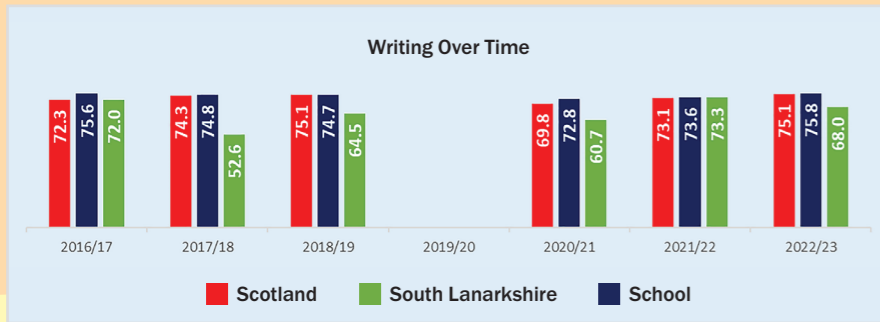

Enable all young people to become successful learners, confident individuals, effective contributors and responsible citizens; and raise attainment in literacy and numeracy.

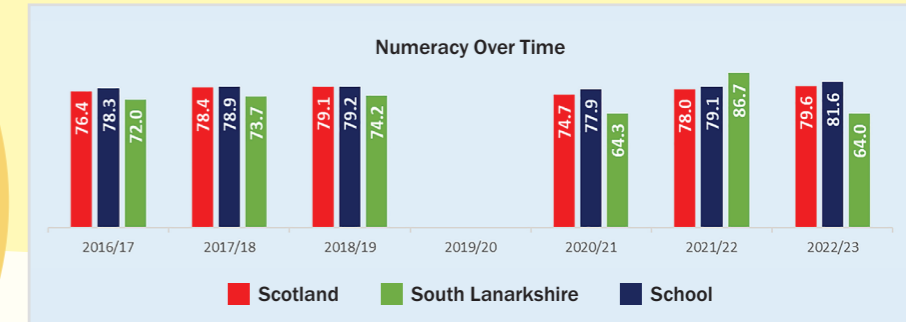
