Strategic Priority	Improvement Priorities 2025/26
1.	Scope out the realms of a VCPA approach across the mainstream school, supported classes and ELC to increase teacher and pupil confidence and begin to raise attainment in Numeracy.
2.	Develop parental involvement and engagement in their child's learning, to improve attendance and participation for target group of learners.
3.	Develop and resource a cohesive and progressive Literacy programme, including CYPIC Writing Improvement Programme.to engage P4 learners, incorporated in a Learning, teaching and Assessment Policy to meet current learners' needs.
4.	Moderation of learning, teaching and assessment across curricular areas relevant to each school/teacher.

3.	Continue to apply the Principles of The Circle Framework in practice, in conjunction with SCERTS.
4.	Update Anti-bullying Policy by enhancing awareness and implementation of updated SLC Anti-Bullying Policy (in light of new National Guidance) which will launch at the Inclusion Conference in September 2025.
